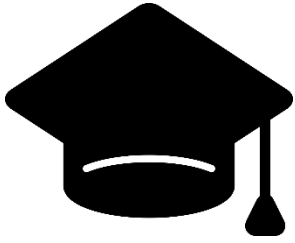


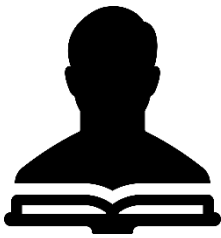
## Strategic Plan Update – October, 2018



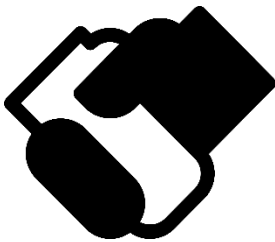
**Academics:** Naviance has been purchased and counselors will be trained on its uses. This tool will allow counselors to help students choose courses based on interests and career goals. The Health and Happiness Committee has been formed and are researching ways to improve the social-emotional wellness of students and staff.



**Facilities/Resources:** Hallways are being painted and new LED lighting installed which brightens the areas. New signage has been added in some areas. The exterior of the building has been enhanced with new structures, signage and foliage. All staff have been given two keys which allows them to enter any classroom in the building. Administration is researching options to FOB all classroom doors.



**Student Experience:** Committees are being formed to address the action steps in this strategy.



**Partnership:** Meetings Workplace Readiness standards are being communicated to stakeholders. Various meetings have been held to determine the best way to communicate this program. Meetings with the Stateline Chamber have been set to discuss ways to develop mutually beneficial relationships.



**Safe Learning Environment:** Shelter in place was reviewed in the 2300 and 2400 hallways. Administration is looking into an app that would be able to track an active intruder and notify staff and students in real time. The “Loss of Privileges” system for discipline was developed over the summer of 2018 and in effect now.
