A representative from the Rock Valley College Financial Aid Office will explain the financial aid process and the importance of completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Seniors who plan to attend a community college/university/vocational school after graduation and want to be considered for financial aid need to submit the Free Application for Student Aid Form (FAFSA). The FAFSA form is used by schools to determine a financial aid package for each prospective student. FAFSA forms should be submitted as soon as possible starting October 1, 2018. Paper copies of the form can be printed or electronic copies can be submitted online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Call 800-433-3243 to have a paper copy of the application mailed to you.
